**b. Significant Weather Features:**

- A low pressure area has formed over Northeast Arabian Sea and adjoining coastal areas of Kutch & south Pakistan. The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto mid-tropospheric levels. A trough extends from this cyclonic circulation to Gangetic West Bengal across central India at low-mid tropospheric levels. Another cyclonic circulation lies over East-central Arabian Sea off Maharashtra coast at mid-tropospheric levels.

#### 4. Other Incident-

- (i) Landslide in Kerala: Landslide occurred in Tata tea Company Pettimudi Munnar Kerala. 13 persons have been reported dead, 12 persons are injured and 53 persons are still missing. Search and Rescue operation continue by NDRF, Fire, Forest, Police, Emergency Response Team and Local Administration.
- (ii) Landslide at Karnataka Update: Landslides incidents occurred on 06.08.2020 in Karnataka- Bhramagiri hills, Bhagamandala, Madikeri Taluk. Search, search and rescue operation continues in Bramgiri Hills, Tala Cauvery, 06 people are missing.
