**Significant Weather Features:**

➤ An off-shore trough at mean sea level runs from north Maharashtra coast to Lakshadweep area. The east-west shear zone runs roughly along 13°N across the peninsular India between 3.1 km and 4.5 km above mean sea level and a cyclonic circulation lies over Eastcentral Arabian Sea off Karnataka coast between 1.5 km and 5.8 km above mean sea level.

- Moderate thunderstorm with lightning very likely at isolated places over Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, East Uttar Pradesh, Vidarbha, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, East Rajasthan, Telangana, Rayalseema, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Interior Karnataka and Uttarakhand during next 12 hours.
- A Low Pressure Area is likely to form over Westcentral Bay of Bengal off Andhra Pradesh coast around 13th September, 2020.

**4. Other Incident-**

Landslide in Kerala Update: Landslide occurred on 07.08.2020 in Tata tea Company Pettimudi, Munnar, Kerala. 65 persons have been reported dead, 12 persons got injured and 05 persons are still missing. The first stage of searching has put to an end by the authorities because of the search of the fifth consecutive day goes in vain. Searching operation for the five missing persons will be resumed when the water level of the river will become normal.
