**Significant Weather Features:**

➤ A Low Pressure area has formed over north Andaman Sea and neighbourhood in the early morning of today the 09<sup>th</sup> October 2020. It lay over north Andaman Sea and adjoining east central Bay of Bengal in the morning (0830 hrs IST) of today, the 09<sup>th</sup> October 2020. It is very likely to move west northwestwards & intensify into a Depression over central Bay of Bengal by tomorrow, the 10<sup>th</sup> October 2020. Further moving west-northwestwards, it is very likely to cross north Andhra Pradesh coast as a Depression during 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020, morning.

- Under its influence, the following adverse weather is likely over Andaman Sea, south & central Bay of Bengal during 9th – 12th October and over Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, Telangana, interior Karnataka and adjoining Maharashtra during 11th & 12th October 2020.
