Significant Weather Features:-

- The present trough in easterly at mean sea level over southwest Bay of Bengal off Tamilnadu Coast and the cyclonic circulation over Comorin area & neighbourhood at lower levels likely to become less marked during next 24 hours. Another trough in easterlies in lower levels is likely to affect south peninsular India from 15th November, 2020. Under the influence of above systems:
 - i) Scattered to fairly widespread rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm & lightning very likely over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Kerala and Lakshadweep area during next 4-5 days.
 - ii) Isolated heavy rain also very likely over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during next 5 days and over Coastal Andhra Pradesh on 16th & 17th November, 2020.
