Significant Weather Features:-

- A trough in easterlies runs from Comorin area to Andaman Sea extending upto 3.1 km above mean sea level. This trough is likely to move closer to the southeast peninsular coast of India by tomorrow. Under the influence of above system:
 - i) Scattered to fairly widespread rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm & lightning and isolated heavy falls is very likely over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 14 -16th November, Coastal Andhra Pradesh during 15- 16th November Rayalseema on 16th November and Kerala on 17-18th November 2020.
- A Western Disturbance lies as a cyclonic circulation at 3.1 km above mean sea level over Afghanistan & neighbourhood with trough aloft roughly along Long. 60°E and to the north of Lat.28°N.Under the influence of the Western Disturbance and its interaction with lower level easterlies:
 - i) Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm, hailstorm & lightning and isolated heavy falls is very likely over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad during 14 -15th November and Himachal Pradesh on 15th November 2020.]
