Significant Weather Features:-

- A cyclonic circulation lies over Maldives area & neighbourhood and a trough in easterlies runs from this circulation to Southeast Arabian Sea in lower levels.
- The above trough is likely to move westwards and under its influence, a Low Pressure Area is likely to form over Southeast Arabian Sea around 19th November, 2020. It is very likely to move west-northwestwards and concentrate into a Depression over Southeast & adjoining Eastcentral Arabian sea during subsequent 48 hours.
- Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm & lightning and isolated heavy rainfall over Kerala and Lakshadweep on 17th & 18th November, 2020 and over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during next 24 hours and reduce thereafter. Isolated to scattered light rainfall activity accompanied with thunderstorm & lightning is very likely over Rayalaseema on 17th and over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 17th & 18th; Scattered to fairly widespread moderate rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm & lightning is very likely over Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep on 19th & 20th November, 2020.
