Significant Weather Features :-

- The Well Marked Low Pressure Area over central Bangladesh and neighbourhood now lies as a Low Pressure Area over the same region. The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto lower-tropospheric levels. Under its influence, light to moderate rainfall/Thunderstorm at many places with isolated heavy falls likely over south Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura today, the 24th October, 2020.
- Conditions are becoming favourable for further withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon from remaining parts of Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat and entire North Arabian sea and from some parts of Odisha, north Maharashtra and Central Arabian Sea during next 48 hours and from the entire country during subsequent 2 days.
