**Significant Weather Features :-**

- Under the influence of cyclonic circulations over Eastcentral Arabian Sea off Karnataka coast and another over southwest Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood in lower tropospheric levels, heavy rainfall likely over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 25th-29th; Kerala & Mahe during 27th-29th and South Interior Karnataka on 27th October, 2020.
- Conditions are becoming favourable for further withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon from remaining parts of Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat and entire North Arabian sea and from some parts of Odisha, north Maharashtra and Central Arabian Sea during next 24 hours and from the entire country during subsequent 2 days.
